 Use of risk information in Japanese nuclear regulation is limited.

- Quantitative risk information is used in
 - Prioritization of inspection targets, and
 - Identification of SA event sequences.



Status Quo (continue)

 In the last Advisors Meeting in November 2023, the importance of communication between regulators and licensees was emphasized.

 The NRA started open meetings with licensees to seek possible joint activities, such as joint safety researches for common objectives.

- One of the joint activities will be the development of evaluation techniques, as well as more specific sub-areas are under discussion.
- The motives of licensees are, at the present, optimization of LCO and AOT, and extension of OLM application.

LCO: limiting conditions for operation AOT: allowed outage time OLM: on-line maintenance
